ATTERTON:

- Atterton Road gates – the gates are ordered! The work is ordered. As soon as the gates are in, LCC will schedule the work and they will be installed.
- Post box – I've not chased this up due to other work pressures.
- Prices obtained for defibrillator, report for July meeting to decide.
- Bench seat for expenditure this meeting.

FENNY DRAYTON:

- ANPR cameras – LCC Officer contacted for information, there's various ways we could do this. Previously advised they breached GDPR, however with new technology we can side-step this. Information forwarded to Ann and Maureen for information. As we have the VAS machines we would need to understand why we would purchase them.

RATCLIFFE CULEY

- Went to see resident regarding the church yard mowing. They had not known where else to look for support and knowing how other parishes assist with such matters asked us. I have given the details supplied by Ann for the Community Payback Team. They were grateful.

WITHERLEY

- Reported the pot hole in Post Office Lane.
- Reported the post hole on Kennel Lane/A5 junction as poor repair.
- Forwarded the S106 application to HBBC for WMPFT.
- Church Road is still an ongoing conversation with LCC.
 - They are unable to alter the course of traffic at the Church Road/Post Office Lane junction due to the lack of sight from the Post Office Lane.
 - They cannot and will not allow us to alter the No Through Road signs as they are Highways standard signs, and must be national standard and dimensions.
 - They are unwilling to paint any messages on the road.
 - I have asked them to contact the satnav folks as it is blatantly a "rubbish-in, rubbish-out" scenario and there must be a way of altering it to reflect the actual road. The officer will find out who has dealt with a similar issue and try to resolve the problem.

PARISH
